World class care at Moanalua Medical Center

Our Moanalua Medical Center has all the essential services needed to provide top-quality care for mom and baby. From our rooms designed for family bonding, to our environments designed for comfort, we provide mom and baby with the best care possible during this important family milestone.

If complications occur during pregnancy or delivery, our specialists are just steps away and available 24/7. We have operating rooms to handle C-sections as well as our level III neonatal intensive care unit (NICU), the highest level of care for preterm babies and those with cardiac, neurological, and surgical needs in the state.

Moanalua Medical Center is one of only two hospitals in the state where mom and baby can stay together at the same facility if they need access to intensive care.



Patient-centered maternity services

To support an expecting family, we take a patient-centered approach, which means members are not left to coordinate services on their own. All expectant mothers work with a dedicated obstetrician, an (optional) certified nurse midwife, nurse practitioners, and a team of specialists. Care teams are linked to the member and each other through HealthConnect, a single health information system that provides real-time access to member medical records. That means that if a prenatal screening indicates problems, a team of obstetricians, perinatologists, and other specialists are readily available for consultation.



Convenient tools and resources to manage your pregnancy

Expectant and new moms can email their doctors, view lab results, make appointments, order prescription refills, and access pregnancy support programs and resources on **kp.org** or our mobile app. Members can visit **kp.org/maternity** to explore articles, videos, checklists, and more to support them in their journey toward parenthood. We also offer various classes to support our members, including birthing, newborn care, and more, as well as tours of Moanalua Medical Center's Family Birth Center prior to baby's birth.



From prenatal to pediatrics

Our integrated care system creates a seamless transition and continuum of care for mom and baby, as mothers recover from child birth and baby is welcomed to the world. Mother and baby are cared for in a private room together for family bonding, and following discharge, both mother and baby will have their first follow-up visit at the Mom and Newborn Center together.

All of mom and baby's caregivers are connected through Kaiser Permanente's network of providers who are also connected to their health records. This integration allows mom and child's entire team to provide quality care and helps prevent care gaps. Whether mom is visiting her primary care physician, or her child is seeing a specialist, they'll have access to their medical records, which helps ensure the best care for both.
