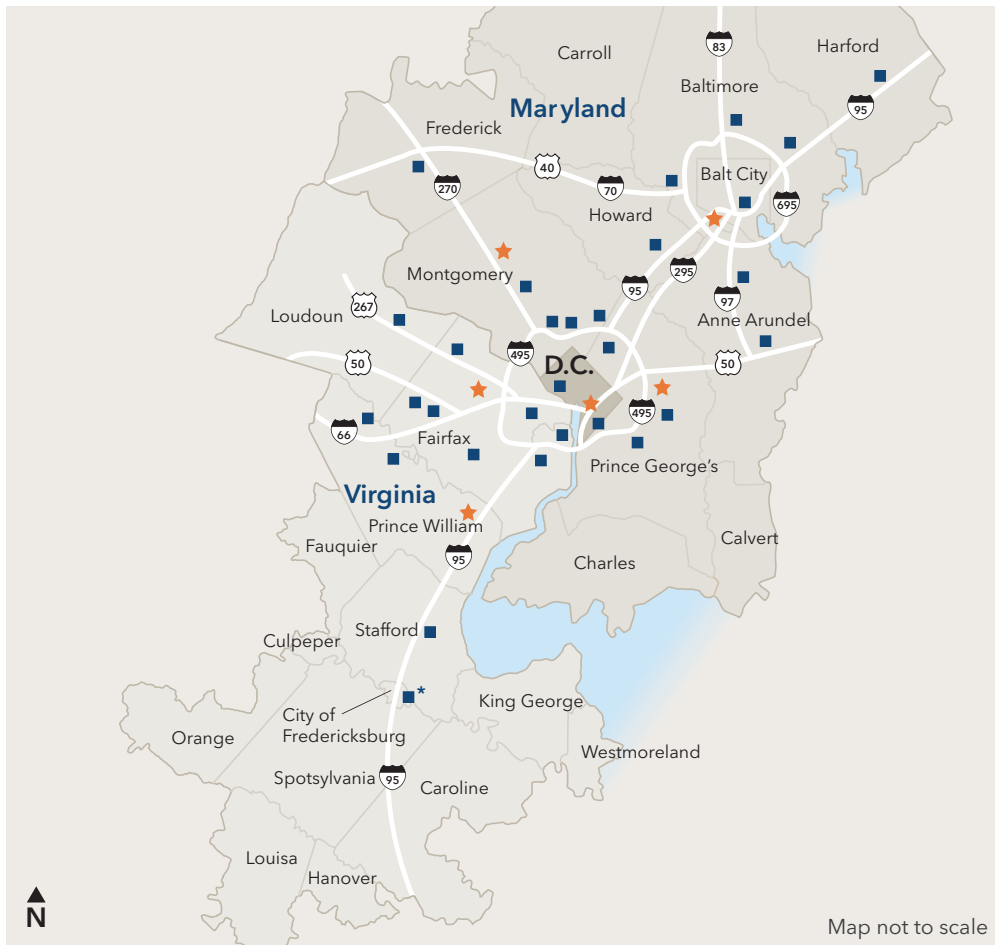


REGIONAL OVERVIEW

Mid-Atlantic States

Kaiser Permanente of the Mid-Atlantic States, headquartered in Rockville, MD, provides and coordinates health care services for more than 700,000 members at 33 locations (as of October 7) in Maryland, Virginia, and Washington, D.C. Three new locations have opened in 2019. Founded in 1980, Kaiser Permanente of the Mid-Atlantic States, Inc., is an integrated total health organization.
