Washington

Kaiser Permanente Washington, headquartered in Seattle, provides and coordinates health care services for roughly 700,000 members, primarily in the Puget Sound region and Spokane. Members receive care from affiliated providers in their plan's service area and more than 970 Kaiser Permanente physicians¹ in 34 locations.²

Pharmacy

We own and operate 25 pharmacies in the Puget Sound and Spokane regions – located in our medical centers. In areas without a Kaiser Permanente pharmacy, we contract with outside pharmacies to provide prescription drug services. PPO and POS plan members have additional access to the OptumRx national network of pharmacies. Members can also refill most of their prescriptions online, over the phone, or through our mobile app.

Medical facilities

Primary, specialty, and allied care

- We own and operate 30 medical facilities with multiple services in our Washington region, plus 4 smaller medical offices that offer limited specialty services.

Hospitals

- We have 51 affiliated Washington hospitals to provide members with inpatient care across our service area. Our hospital-based specialists practice at 8 of those locations. Our POS and PPO members have access to additional hospitals in Washington and nationally.
