Available providers

PPO Plus® offers 2 levels of coverage. They determine which health care providers you see, which medical facilities you use, and how much you pay.



PPO provider network

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- Our PPO provider network is served by First Choice Health (the largest independent PPO network in the Northwest), First Health Network,* and Kaiser Permanente providers.
- We selected First Choice Health because we trust its more than 50,000 providers to help reduce health care costs and improve health care benefits, without sacrificing quality and convenience.
- Our Kaiser Permanente providers and facilities are also available to you.
- Under the PPO provider network, your copay, coinsurance, and deductible are at the same level, regardless of which PPO provider or PPO facility you choose.

- Members in Oregon and Washington can call for advice anytime at **1-800-813-2000**.
- If you need a procedure, ask your provider to request prior authorization at **1-855-281-1840**.

Nonparticipating providers

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- If you want to see a provider who's not in the PPO provider network, you can still choose to see that provider.
- While this option offers greater choice of providers, it also has a higher out-of-pocket cost with the potential of additional billing from your provider.

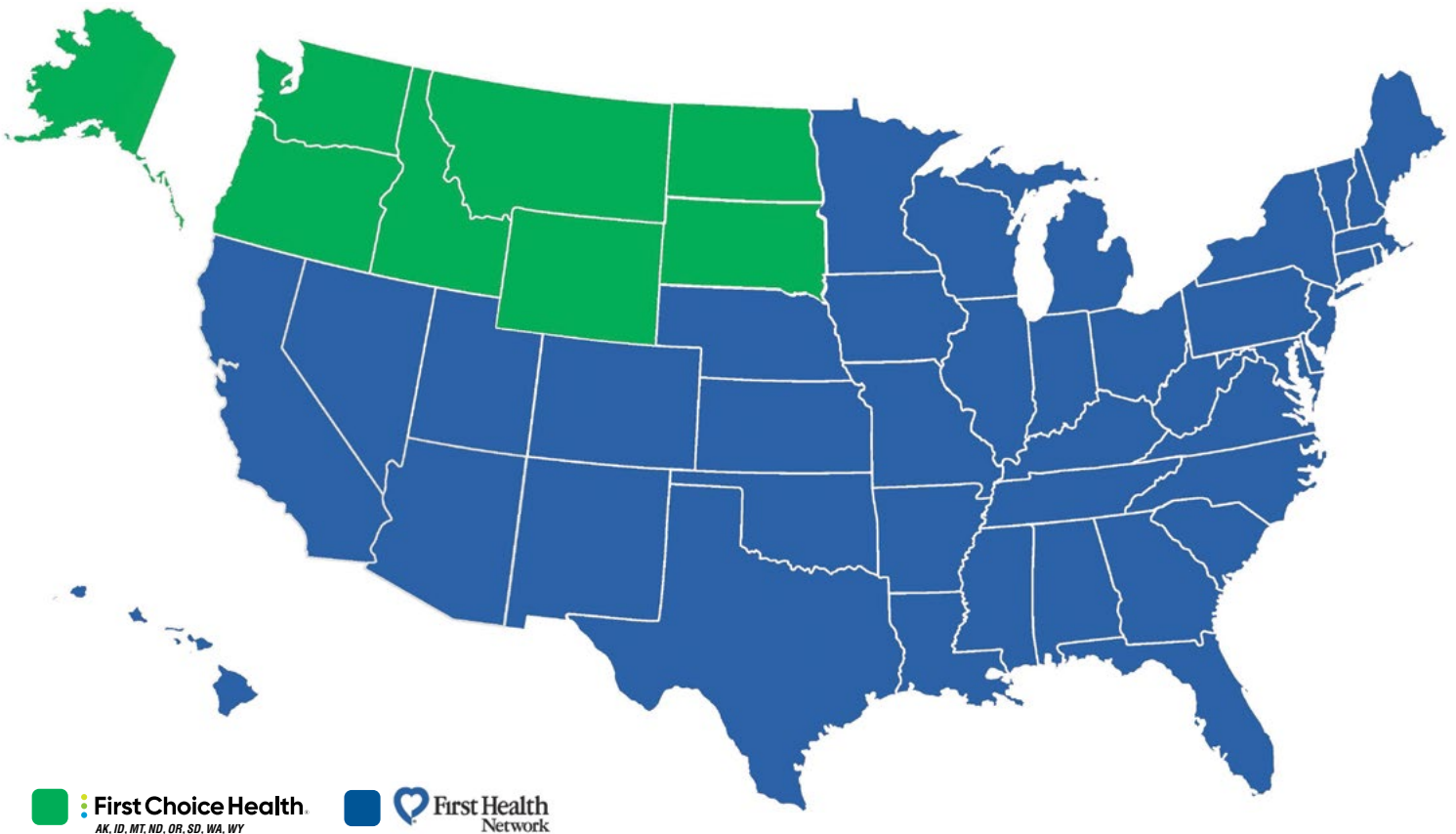

NONPARTICIPATING PROVIDERS

Your nonparticipating provider benefits cover care you receive from any licensed provider (outside the PPO provider network).

- You can call the provider's office directly to make an appointment.
- Most providers do not require a referral for specialty care. However, this is determined by the specialty provider, so please inquire with them when scheduling your appointment. You will need prior authorization for some services and procedures. You must call **1-855-281-1840 (TTY 711)** for prior authorization.
- Your doctor may require you to pay the full cost of the visit. And you will need to submit claim forms and itemized bills for reimbursement.

When using a nonparticipating provider or facility, you will be responsible for the amount you are billed above the maximum allowable charge set out in your *EOC* – this is referred to as balance billing. These charges billed directly by your provider do not apply to your deductible or out-of-pocket maximum.

*This number can be dialed inside and outside the United States. Before the phone number, dial "001" for landlines and "+1" for mobile lines if you're outside the country. Long-distance charges may apply, and we can't accept collect calls. The phone line is closed on major holidays (New Year's Day, Easter, Memorial Day, July Fourth, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas). It closes early the day before a holiday at 10 p.m. Pacific time (PT), and it reopens the day after a holiday at 4 a.m. PT.

Pharmacy coverage

With PPO Plus, you have in-network access to the Kaiser Permanente and the MedImpact pharmacy network, including most national pharmacy chains and many local pharmacies.*

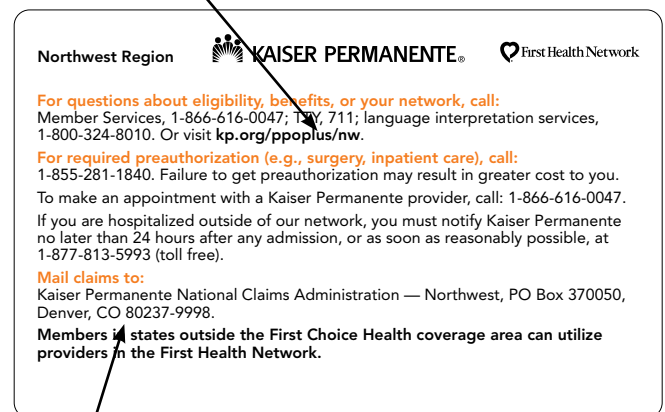
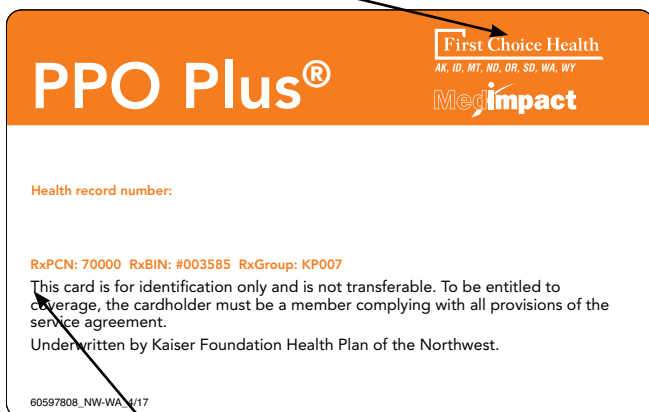

*Not all plans have a network pharmacy benefit, nor do all plans have a select pharmacy rider. For Oregon and Washington residents, consult your benefit summary. For all other residents, consult your Outpatient Prescription Drug Rider. Your EOC provides a complete definition of select pharmacy.

Prior authorization

Prior authorization: Prior authorization is required for some services. Prior authorization requires 48 hours' notice. For a summary of care that requires preauthorization and a prior authorization form, go to kp.org/ppoplus/nw, click the "For Members" tab, and then click "Prior authorization approval."

To obtain prior authorization or for questions about medical necessity requirements, please call Kaiser Permanente's Resource Stewardship Department at **1-855-281-1840 (TTY 711)**.

Kaiser Permanente specialist referral: Outside medical providers can refer to a Kaiser Permanente specialist through the Regional Referral Department of Kaiser Permanente. Regional Referral will review the medical case and work with the non-Kaiser Permanente provider so the Kaiser Permanente specialist has what they need to deliver a positive member experience to the patient. 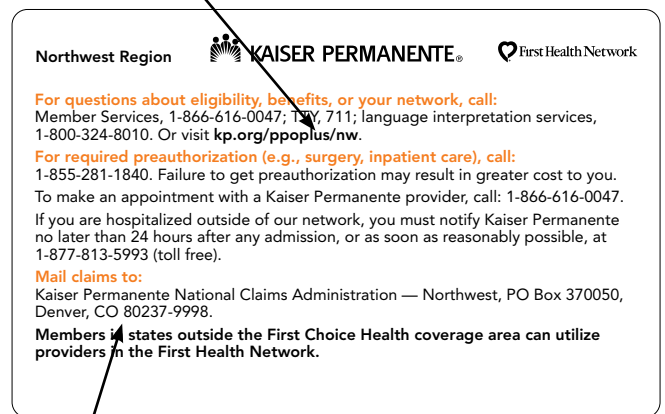
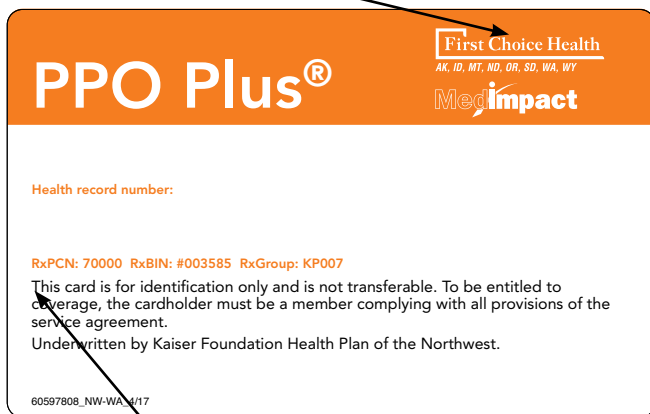
